This scholarship is awarded to a working mother enrolled at CLC who desires to further her education and requires funding for the education process (tuition, books, etc.).

## Qualifications:

1. Recipient must be a working mother.
2. Recipient must currently attend The College of Lake County, Lake County, Illinois.
3. Recipient must be seeking an associate, undergraduate or graduate degree.

## Procedures:

1. Submit the information and/or materials outlined below:
  - Application information sheet
  - Personal statement outlining personal and professional goals
  - One letter of recommendation
  - An official transcript of grades
2. The LJWC Scholarship Committee will select a panel of judges from their membership who will interview the top candidates and select the scholarship recipient. You will be notified regarding the status of your application in April.
3. Payment will be made to the Financial Aid authority of the program in which the student is registered. In some cases, the payment may be made directly to the student. If you are chosen as the recipient of this scholarship proper information on who the check should be made payable to and address provided to submit it to your educational institution.
